Spring-flowering bulbs

How to plant flower bulbs:



Make a hole about twice as deep as the bulb is high. Place the flower bulb, or several bulbs.



Close the hole with earth again. Water the bulbs after planting so that they start to grow.

When to plant?

Spring-flowering bulbs such as daffodils and tulips can best be planted from September to December, preferably for the first night frost.

Where to plant?

Bulbs can be planted in different ways: spread out in a border, in groups, between lawn or on the terrace or balcony in a pot or flower box
